Patience and Fortitude, the world-renowned pair of marble lions that stand proudly before the majestic Beaux-Arts Building at Fifth Avenue and 42 nd Street in Manhattan, have captured the imagination and affection of New Yorkers and visitors from all of the world since the library was dedicated on May 23, 1911.
